WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, has determined that a need for a Supplemental Appropriation exists to enable the City to enter into a contract for the construction of a certain fire substation, and


WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, has determined that there exists additional revenue available to the municipality, or estimated to be received by the municipality, which said revenue was not known to, or available to, the City of Urbana prior to the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance, to-wit: sales tax and general property taxes made available through certain properties having annexed to the City,

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:


Section 1. There be, and is hereby appropriated, for the object and purpose of constructing a new fire substation facility on North Lincoln Avenue in the City of Urbana, the additional sum of \$18,000.00.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force ten (10) days after its passage, approval and publication, as required by law.
