

ORDINANCE NO. 7172-79

ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY
TO THE CITY OF URBANA

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described territory is situated in unincorporated territory adjacent to and contiguous to the City of Urbana, Illinois, and is part of the Philo Fire Protection District, and Notice was given to the Trustees of the said Fire Protection District, said Notice being mailed on December 21, 1971, that this Ordinance would be voted upon at the regular meeting of this Council at 7:30 P.M., Monday, January 17, 1972, and the Affidavit of mailing such notices was duly recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County, Illinois, and

WHEREAS, a written Petition signed by all of the owners of Record and all electors residing therein, of all land within such territory, has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, requesting annexation thereof to the City of Urbana, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that said Petition complies with all requirements of the law therefor, and

WHEREAS, the majority of the Aldermen are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the People of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said Territory be annexed to and made a part of the said City,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

Section 1. That the following described real estate, viz:

The West 800 feet of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of Section 21, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian of Champaign County, Illinois; except the North 16 1/2 feet thereof; and also excepting the South 660 feet thereof,

commonly known as: A vacant tract of land located South and East of the intersection of Philo Road and Florida Avenue, Urbana, Illinois,

be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Urbana, Illinois.

Section 2. That the City Clerk be authorized and directed to file for record a certified copy of this Ordinance together with an accurate map of the territory here-

inabove described in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds for Champaign County, Illinois.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage and recording as provided by law.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 17th day of January, A.D. 1972.
