

ORDINANCE NO. 7172-81

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL CENSUS

WHEREAS, since January 1, 1970, it is believed that the CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, has annexed territory wherein approximately two hundred forty (240) persons live, and


WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interests of the CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, to have an official census conducted as to such area,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. The Corporate Authorities herewith and hereby authorize the Mayor of the CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, to enter into any necessary agreements to conduct a special census of the territory annexed to the CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, since January 1, 1970.


