

ORDINANCE NO. 7172-93

ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY
TO THE CITY OF URBANA

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described territory is situated in unincorporated territory adjacent to and contiguous to the City of Urbana, Illinois, and is not part of any Fire Protection District, and

WHEREAS, a written Petition signed by all of the owners of Record and all electors residing therein, of all land within such territory, has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, requesting annexation thereof to the City of Urbana, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that said Petition complies with all requirements of the law therefor, and

WHEREAS, the majority of the Aldermen are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the People of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said Territory be annexed to and made a part of the said City,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

Section 1. That the following described real estate, viz:

That part of the West 701.52 feet of the North 412.00 feet of the N.E. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Section 21, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the 3rd P.M., except the West 157.00 feet of the North 240.00 feet thereof, which lies East of the East line of Cottage Grove Avenue, containing 5.51 acres more or less; and also Cottage Grove Avenue from the South line of Florida Avenue to the South line extended of the above said tract;

and Sunnycrest Drive from the present City Limits East to the West line of Cottage Grove Avenue, all situated in Champaign County, Illinois,

more commonly known as 1107, 1201, 1203 and 1209 Florida Avenue, Urbana, Illinois,

be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Urbana, Illinois.

Section 2. That the City Clerk be authorized and directed to file for record a certified copy of this Ordinance together with an accurate map of the territory hereinabove described in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds for Champaign County, Illinois.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage and recording as provided by law.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes"

and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana,
Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 20th day of MARCH,
A.D. 1972.
