

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING MOTOR VEHICLE PARKING
ON CERTAIN PORTIONS OF BROADWAY AVENUE
IN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,
A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois, and the City of Urbana, Illinois, a municipal corporation, for improved traffic movement, and public safety, contemplate an improvement of a bridge on North Broadway Avenue from Station 2+00 to Station 4+00 in said City, during the calendar year 1972, in accordance with estimates, plans, maps, drawings, and specifications, and contemplated agreements, and pursuant to the project designation of F.A.P. Type II System, State Section T-5181 (2), City Section, 153-BR-CS, City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, FOR SAID CITY, that motor vehicle parking and any parking is hereby prohibited on Broadway Avenue, in said City, on both sides for 150 feet South of the Centerline of the Saline Ditch to 150 feet North of the Centerline of Saline Ditch, in said City.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1 - 2 - 4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 3rd day of July, 1972.
