ORDINANCE NO. 7273-16

ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF URBANA

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described territory is situated in unincorporated territory adjacent to and contiguous to the City of Urbana, Illinois, and is part of the Edge-Scott Fire Protection District, and Notice was given to the Trustees of the said Fire Protection District, said Notice being mailed on June 15th, 1972, that this Ordinance would be voted upon at the regular meeting of this Council at 7:30 P.M., Monday, July 3, 1972, and the Affidavit of mailing such notices was duly recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County, Illinois, and

WHEREAS, a written Petition signed by all of the owners of Record and all electors residing therein, of all land within such territory, has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, requesting annexation thereof to the City of Urbana, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that said Petition complies with all requirements of the law therefor, and

WHEREAS, the majority of the Aldermen are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the People of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said Territory be annexed to and made a part of the said City,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

Section 1. That the following described real estate, viz:

Lot 1143 of Country Squire Estates Subdivision

commonly known as 2014 Country Squire Drive, Urbana, Illinois

be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Urbana, Illinois.

Section 2. That the following described real estate, viz:

Country Squire Drive from the West line of lot 1144 extended to the East line of lot 1143 extended of said Subdivision, said tract being a street right-of-way all situated in Champaign County, Illinois

be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Urbana, Illinois.

Section 3. That the City Clerk be authorized and directed to file for record a certified copy of this Ordinance together with an accurate map of the territory here-inabove described in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds for Champaign County, Illinois.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage and recording as provided by law.
