WHEREAS, the Chief of the Fire Department of the City of Urbana, Illinois, the Fire Marshall, recommends to the City Council that a fire hydrant be located at the following location, and

WHEREAS, it appears to be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, for public safety and fire protection to have such fire hydrant located, and

WHEREAS, there is a necessity for the location of the fire hydrant at the following specified location;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that a fire hydrant be located in the City of Urbana, Illinois, at the following location:

Between lots 11 and 12 on the South side of East Michigan Street, East of Vine Street, Urbana, Illinois.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the City Clerk of said City is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this ordinance to the Northern Illinois Water Corporation.


