AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 4.1 OF THE URBANA CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

that:

Section 1. Section 4.1 of the Urbana City Code, which reads as

follows:

"Sec. 4.1. Circuses, carnivals, menageries, etc., prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person to present, conduct, display, or cause to be presented, conducted or displayed, any circuses, carnivals, menageries, caravans, side shows or exhibitions of freaks of nature or monsters within the corporate limits of the city. (6-1-53, s. 1; Code 1954, s. 4.1)"

is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. All remaining Sections of Chapter 4 shall be renumbered accordingly.

Section 3. This repealing ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage by the City Council and the approval by the Mayor.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 31 day of largust, 1972.
