

ORDINANCE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ALTERED SPEED ZONE

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Urbana has caused to be made an engineering and traffic investigation upon the street listed in the following schedule, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Urbana has determined, on the basis of the aforesaid investigation, that the maximum speed limit prescribed in Section 11-601, of Chapter 95 1/2, Illinois Revised Statutes 1971 is greater, or less, than is reasonable or safe with respect to conditions found to exist at the places or along the part or zone of the following described highway or street,

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, STATE OF ILLINOIS, that:

The basic statutory vehicular speed limit established by Section 11-601 of Chapter 95 1/2, Illinois Revised Statutes 1971 are greater, or less, than that considered reasonable or safe on the street listed in the following schedule, which said street is located within the Corporate Limits of the City of Urbana, and which is not under the jurisdiction of either the Department of Public Works and Buildings of the State of Illinois, or under the jurisdiction of the State Toll Highway Commission, and for which the County or Highway Commissioner does not have maintenance responsibility;


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that, by virtue of Section 11-604 of Chapter 95 1/2, Illinois Revised Statutes 1971, the City Council of Urbana determines and declares that the reasonable and proper absolute maximum speed limit upon this street described in the above Schedule shall be as stated therein.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Council has approved the proposed maximum speed limit for the zone or zones of said street or highway described in the above Schedule, and that signs giving notice thereof shall be erected in conformance with the standards and specifications contained in the Illinois Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Street and Highways.


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1 - 2 - 4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.
