

ORDINANCE NO. 7273-31

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX FOR STREET AND BRIDGE PURPOSES,
 IN THE TOWN OF CUNNINGHAM, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS,
 FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 1972, AND ENDING APRIL 30, 1973

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana, Illinois, includes wholly within its corporate limits, the Town of Cunningham, and therefore, comes within the provisions of Sections 11-81-1 and 2 of the Illinois Municipal Code of Chapter 24 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Illinois, for the levying of a street and bridge tax,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:


SECTION 1. That there be and is hereby levied upon all taxable property within the Township of Cunningham, Champaign County, Illinois, lying wholly within the corporate limits of the City of Urbana, Illinois, for street and bridge purposes in the Town of Cunningham, Champaign County, Illinois, the sum of \$85,000.00, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 11-81-1 and 2 of the Illinois Municipal Code of Chapter 24 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 2. That this levy totaling \$85,000.00 be and is in addition to (1) any and all taxes that such municipality is now authorized to levy for street and bridge purposes, and (2) any and all taxes that such municipality is now authorized to levy upon all property within the municipality, and (3) any and all other taxes authorized to be levied by the City of Urbana, for general corporate purposes as provided in Section 8-3-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code of Chapter 24 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Illinois, and shall be expended as follows:




