

AMENDMENT TO A PART OF ZONING ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, after due publication, a public hearing was held on the 14th day of August, 1972, concerning the Petition filed in Planning Commission Case #892, and

WHEREAS, the Urbana Plan Commission approved the request that the property herein described below be changed from AG, Agriculture, to I-1, Light Industrial,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. The Zoning Ordinance of the City of Urbana, and the Zoning Map of Urbana, Illinois, is herewith and hereby amended to amend the zoning classification of the following described area to that of I-1, Light Industrial:

The Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 33; the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 33; and the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section.

The said area above described being represented on the map attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1 - 2 - 4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1972.
