

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 21.20  
OF THE URBANA CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

that:

Section 1. Section 21.20 of the Urbana City Code, which reads as

follows:

"Sec. 21.20. Endurance contests.

It shall be unlawful for any person to advertise, operate, maintain, promote or aid in advertising, operating, promoting or maintaining any mental or physical endurance contest in the nature of a marathon, walkathon, skatathon or any other such endurance contest of a like or similar nature, whether under that or similar names. Nothing in this section shall be construed to apply to the continuance of the ordinary amateur or professional athletic events or contests of grade school, high school, college or inter-collegiate sports. (5-21-34, s. 1; Code 1954, s. 21.15.)"


IS HEREBY REPEALED IN ITS ENTIRETY.

Section 2. This repealing ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage by the City Council and the approval by the Mayor.


