

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NO PARKING ZONES
AND A LOADING ZONE ON ILLINOIS STREET

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

that:

1. Parking shall be prohibited at all times in the following described

areas:

(a) On the South side of Illinois Street from Gregory Street to a point 86 feet East of the Centerline of Gregory Street.

(b) On the South side of Illinois Street from a point 171 feet East of the Centerline of Gregory Street to a point 237 feet East of the Centerline of Gregory Street.

2. The following described area shall be designated "Loading Zone"

and parking shall be prohibited therein except for persons actually engaged in loading or unloading of a motor vehicle: on the South side of Illinois Street between the two areas designated as no parking zones in Paragraph One above.


3. The Commissioner of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to install appropriate signs and markings designating the above areas in accordance with State of Illinois Traffic Manual requirements.

4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1 - 2 - 4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

5. This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 2nd day of October, 1972.


