

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.2

1. Section 2.2 of the Urbana City Code be, and such is hereby,
amended to repeal Subsection 5 thereof and in its place insert the following language:


(5) The eleventh day of November (Veterans Day).

by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.


This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes"

Section 1. Parking shall be prohibited at all times in the following described area:


On East Main Street from 1700 East to end of new project.


