

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ALTERNATE
PARKING ON MAIN STREET

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

that:

Section 1. Parking be prohibited on the North side of the following described area Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, and prohibited on the South side of the street Thursday, Friday and Saturday:

Main Street from Lincoln Avenue to Cedar Street.

Section 2. The Commissioner of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to install appropriate signs and markings designating the above areas in accordance with State and Illinois Traffic Manual requirements.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1 - 2 - 4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 6th day of November, 1972.
