BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,
that:

Section 1. Parking shall be prohibited at all times in
the following described area:


On the West side of Orchard Street

terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.


Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative
