WHEREAS, it appears to be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, for public safety and fire protection to have such fire hydrant located, and,


WHEREAS, there is a necessity for the location of the fire hydrant at the following specified location;

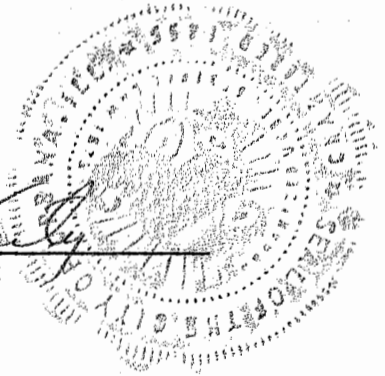
The Southeast Corner of Lierman and Hunter Streets.


