

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 34.114 and 34.115
OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Urbana Plan Commission, after due notice and public hearing being held and upon due consideration, has forwarded to this Council Case #902, recommending that the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Urbana, Illinois, be amended as suggested therein.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. A new subsection 7 shall be added to Section 34.114 (B) which shall read as follows:

7. Relocated unless such relocation brings the sign into conformance with all the requirements of this ordinance except that where a nonconforming sign is located within right-of-way taken or acquired by a public body for street improvement purposes then the relocation of such a sign is permitted provided that the relocation of such a nonconforming sign shall not extend the requirements for removal as set forth in Section 34.114 (C) 2.

Section 2. At the end of the second paragraph of Section 34.115 (A) the following sentence shall be added:

A permit is required for relocation of nonconforming signs as provided for in Section 34.114 (B-7) of this ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1 - 2 - 4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

A permit is required for relocation of nonconforming signs as provided for in Section 34.114 (B-7) of this ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.
