BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

that:

Section 1. Parking shall be prohibited at all times in the following described area:

East side of Vine Street from Washington to Fairlawn.

Section 2. Parking shall be prohibited at all times on both sides of the street in the following described area:


Along Cottage Grove from Oregon to the railroad tracks.

Section 3. The Commissioner of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to install appropriate signs and markings designating the above areas in accordance with State and Illinois Traffic Manual requirements.





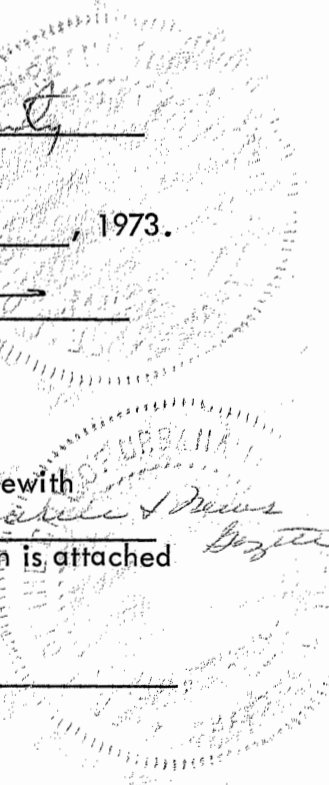
