

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 7071-90  
(ADOPTING THE LIFE SAFETY CODE)

WHEREAS, on March 15, 1971, the City of Urbana adopted the Life Safety Code, 1970 Edition, and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the City of Urbana have determined that the provisions of Section 11-3331 of the said Life Safety Code do not adequately protect the safety of the citizens of the City of Urbana,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. Ordinance Number 7071-90 is herewith and hereby amended by deleting the present wording of Section 11-3331 of the Life Safety Code, 1970 Edition and substituting therefore the following:

"11-3331 Every apartment building shall be provided with automatic sprinkler protection in accordance with Section 6-4, or automatic fire alarms in accordance with Section 6-3 if such apartment building is more than three (3) stories in height or more than twelve (12) apartment units."


Section 2. This Amendment shall apply only to buildings constructed or remodeled pursuant to a building permit applied for after the effective date of this Ordinance.


Section 3. Any person convicted of a violation of this Ordinance shall be fined in accordance with Section 1.6 of the Urbana City Code.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1973.
