

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION OF ALCHOLIC LIQUOR IN AUTOMOBILES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

that:

Section 1. The present Section 16.25 of the Urbana City Code is repealed upon the taking effect of this Ordinance.

Section 2. That in place of the existing Section 16.25 is herewith enacted a new Section 16.25, reading as follows:

"Sec. 16.25. No person shall transport, carry, possess or have any alcoholic liquor within the passenger area of any motor vehicle except in the original package and with the seal unbroken."

Section 3. A person convicted of violating this Ordinance shall be fined not more than TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) in accordance with Section 1.6 of the Urbana City Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1 - 2 - 4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of July, 1973.
