Illinois, at the following locations:

- 1. Southeast corner of Willow Road and Bradley Avenue
- 2. Southeast corner of Florida and Adams Streets
- 3. Southwest corner of Florida and Philo Road
- 4. North side of Florida Avenue, 300 feet East of Adams Street

 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the City Clerk of said City is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Northern Illinois Water Corporation.
