

AN ORDINANCE FOR LOCATION OF FIRE HYDRANTS

WHEREAS, the Chief of the Fire Department of the City of Urbana, Illinois, the Fire Marshall, recommends to the City Council that fire hydrants be located at the following locations, and

WHEREAS, it appears to be for the best interests of the People of the City of Urbana, Illinois, for public safety and fire protection to have such fire hydrants located, and

WHEREAS, there is a necessity for the location of fire hydrants at the following specified locations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that fire hydrants be located in the City of Urbana, Illinois, at the following locations:


1. Southeast corner of Willow Road and Bradley Avenue
2. Southeast corner of Florida and Adams Streets
3. Southwest corner of Florida and Philo Road
4. North side of Florida Avenue, 300 feet East of Adams Street

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the City Clerk of said City is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Northern Illinois Water Corporation.


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage and recording as provided by law.
