

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 16.7 AND 16.8
OF THE URBANA CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. The existing Sections 16.7 and 16.8 of the Urbana City Code are hereby repealed upon the taking effect of this Ordinance. The passage of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity or the amount payable for any existing liquor license issued prior to the passage thereof, but any license issued after the effective date of this Ordinance shall require the payment of the amounts called for herein.

Section 2. The new Section 16.7 shall read as follows:

Sec. 16.7. License fees.

Class A license	\$1,450.00
Class AA license	\$1,450.00
Class AA-1 license	\$700.00
Class B license	\$600.00
Class BB license	\$600.00
Class BBB license	\$600.00
Class C license	\$1,175.00
Class D license	\$750.00
Special one-day, eight-hour license	\$25.00

Section 3. The new Section 16.8 shall read as follows:

Sec. 16.8. Number of licenses.

Not more than one Class A license shall be issued in any one year for each 2,000 population of the City. Not more than one Class AA license shall be issued in any one year for each 5,000 population of the City. Not more than one Class B, Class BB or Class BBB license shall be issued for each 2,000 population of the City. Not more than one Class C license shall be issued for each 5,000 population of the City. The population of the City for such purposes shall be determined by the latest motor fuel tax census or by the Federal census, whichever is later.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of

the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the
15th day of October, 1973.

Section 3. The new Section 16.8 shall read as follows: Sec. 16.8. Number of licenses.

Not more than one Class A license shall be issued in any one year for each 2,000 population of the City. Not more than one Class AA license shall be issued in any one year for each 5,000 population of the City. Not more than one Class B, Class BB or Class BBB license shall be issued for each 2,000 population of the City. Not more than one Class C license shall be issued for each 5,000 population of the City. The population of the City for such purposes shall be determined by the latest motor fuel tax census or by the Federal census, whichever is later.
