

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND VARIOUS ORDINANCES RELATING
TO DUTIES OF COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC WORKS AND
CREATING THE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATOR, CODE ENFORCEMENT
DEPARTMENT, AND ASSIGNING CERTAIN DUTIES THERETO

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

that:

Section 1. The present language of Section 2.38 of the Urbana City Code is hereby repealed and in its place is enacted the following:

"Sec. 2.38. Creation and nature of office.

There is hereby created the office of Commissioner of Public Works who shall be ex officio superintendent of streets, and who shall perform all the duties and have all the powers, unless the same are otherwise delegated, prescribed by this Code for the office of superintendent of streets, as well as those duties conferred on the Commissioner of Public Works."

Section 2. The present language of Section 2.41 of the Urbana City Code is hereby repealed and in its place is enacted the following:

"Sec. 2.41. Administrator, Code Enforcement Department

There is hereby created the office of Administrator, Code Enforcement Department; such officer shall be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the City Council. The duties of the Administrator, Code Enforcement Department shall be as follows:

- 1) The Administrator, Code Enforcement Department, shall be the building official of the City and shall issue all building permits and carry on all duties of the building official as such term is used elsewhere in City Ordinances.
- 2) The Administrator, Code Enforcement Department shall perform other such duties as prescribed by the Mayor of Council from time to time.

Section 3. The present language of Section 2.64 of the Urbana City Code is hereby repealed and in its place is enacted the following:

"Sec. 2.64. Board of Local Improvements.

The Board of Local Improvements of the City of Urbana is hereby created. Such Board shall be comprised of the Mayor, who shall be its president, the Public Engineer of the City and the Commissioner of Public Works. The Board of Local Improvements shall have the powers and perform the duties assigned to it by Statute or Ordinance."

Section 4. In each place in Section 8.6 of the Urbana City Code wherein the words "Commissioner of Public Works" appears, such words are hereby repealed and in their place shall be enacted the words "Building Official".

Section 5. The present language of Section 12.8 of the Urbana City Code is hereby repealed and in its place is enacted the following:

"Sec. 12.8. Permit required for the storage of liquified petroleum gases in fire zones.

No equipment or tank of capacity in excess of two hundred pounds to be used for storage or for the utilization of liquified petroleum gases shall be installed within any fire zone of the City unless a permit therefor shall have first been secured.

When such installation is in a building being newly constructed or remodeled in accordance with a permit for such construction or remodeling, no extra fee for the permit shall be required. In other cases, application for such permit shall be made to the Chief, Urbana Fire Department, or his duly designated representative and shall contain a description of the location, equipment and intended use of such equipment. The fee for such permit shall be two dollars (\$2.00).

The Chief, Urbana Fire Department, or his duly designated representative shall not grant the permit unless the proposed installation complies with the standards set forth in Booklet No. 58 of the National Fire Protection Association, as adopted in Section 12.6 of this Code.

Section 6. In each place in Section 14.6 of the Urbana City Code wherein the words "Commissioner of Public Works" are used, the said words are hereby repealed and in their place is enacted the words "Administrator, Code Enforcement Department".

Section 7. In Section 14.18 of Chapter 23:

a) Repeal the following words from the first sentence:

"of whom the Commissioner of Public Works shall be a member and Secretary."

b) Delete the following words from the fourth sentence:

"In addition to Commissioner of Public Works"

and capitalize the "T" in "the" immediately following the words so repealed.

c) Change the word "six (6)" to "five (5)" in the first sentence.

Section 8. In Section 20.12 of the Urbana City Code wherein the words "Commissioner of Public Works" are used, such words are hereby repealed and in their place shall be enacted the words "the City Engineer".

Section 9. In Section 30.12 of the Urbana City Code wherein the words "Commissioner of Public Works" are used, such words are hereby repealed

and in their place shall be enacted the words "Administrator, Code Enforcement Department".

Section 10. In Section 34.88 of the Urbana City Code wherein the words "Commissioner of Public Works" are used, such words are hereby repealed and in their place shall be enacted the words "Administrator, Code Enforcement Department".

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage and recording as provided by law.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 3rd day of December, A.D. 1973.
