

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING RIGHT TURNS AT
CERTAIN INTERSECTIONS

WHEREAS, Public Act 78-24 (Chapter 95 1/2, Section 11-306) effective January 1, 1974, permits vehicular traffic to turn right after stopping at a red light, and

WHEREAS, the said Act also permits local authorities to prohibit any such right turn at any intersection under its jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Urbana, Illinois, finds that in the following intersections a right turn on a red light would constitute a great hazard to pedestrians,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. No driver of a motor vehicle shall proceed through an intersection nor be permitted to turn right if such driver is facing a steady red signal at such intersection, if such intersection is one of the following named:


- a) Wright and Green Streets
- b) Main and Broadway Streets
- c) Main and Race Streets

Section 2. The Traffic Engineer of the City of Urbana, Illinois, is hereby authorized and directed to cause signs to be erected giving notice of this Ordinance at each of the above said intersections.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect as of January 1, 1974.



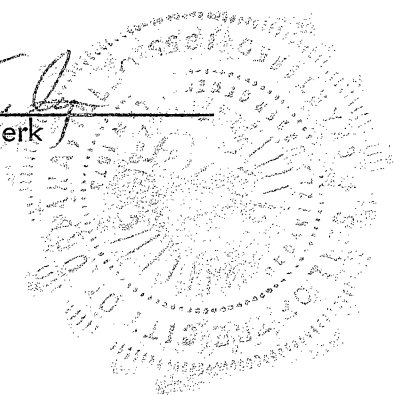
