

AN ORDINANCE FOR LOCATION OF FIRE HYDRANTS

WHEREAS, the Chief of the Fire Department of the City of Urbana, Illinois, the Fire Marshall, recommends to the City Council that fire hydrants be located at the following locations, and,

WHEREAS, it appears to be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, for public safety and fire protection to have such fire hydrants located, and


WHEREAS, there is a necessity for the location of fire hydrants at the following specified locations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that fire hydrants be located in the City of Urbana, Illinois, at the following locations:

1. On Willow Road, 400 feet north of the south side of Bradley Avenue.
2. On Lincolnwood Drive between lots 128 and 129.
3. On the southeast corner of Lincolnwood and Florida Avenue.


