

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PROHIBITED PARKING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

that:

Section 1. Parking shall be prohibited at all times in the following described area:


On Broadway from the Park entrance to Oakland and on Kerr Avenue from Broadway to North Highland Drive.

Section 2. The Commissioner of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to install appropriate signs and markings designating the above said area in accordance with State and Illinois Traffic Manual requirements.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1 - 2 - 4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.


