

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 31.46
OF THE URBANA CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. Upon this Ordinance coming into effect, the present Section 31.46 of the Urbana City Code is herewith repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. In place of the above repealed Section 31.46, the following is hereby enacted:

Sec. 31.46. Rates of fare - Generally.

The fares and charges for taxicab service for one passenger shall be Seventy (70¢) cents for the first one-sixth mile or fraction thereof, and ten (10¢) cents for each additional one-sixth mile or fraction thereof; and if more than one passenger is carried on the same trip, there shall be an additional charge of then (10¢) cents for each such additional passenger who leaves the taxicab prior to or at the time the meter is cleared, provided that on days of University of Illinois home football games, between the hours of 11:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M., the fare per person to and from the business district of the city and the University of Illinois Memorial Stadium shall be Fifty (50¢) cents. The business districts referred to herein shall be construed to mean the area bounded by Cedar Street (and Cedar Street extended North), University Avenue, Vine Street, and Illinois Street.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect after its passage, approval and publication at 12:01 A.M. on April 1, 1974.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication, at 12:01 A.M. on April 1, 1974, in accordance with the terms of Section 1 - 2 - 4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the Members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 18TH day of MARCH, 1974.
