

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5.14 OF THE  
URBANA CITY CODE (NOISY DOGS)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. The present Section 5.14 of the Urbana City Code is hereby repealed upon the taking effect of this Ordinance.

Section 2. In place of the repealed Section 5.14 the following is hereby enacted:

Sec. 5.14. Noisy dogs.

Any person who harbors a dog which howls and whines or barks constantly so as to disturb the peace and quiet of the neighborhood, shall be guilty of maintaining a nuisance and shall be subject to the general penalty set forth in section 1.6 of this Code. This ordinance shall not apply to veterernarian clinics or animal boarding business in existence on May 1, 1974, during daylight hours until ten (10) years from the approval of this ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective ten days after its passage and publication as provided by law.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the Members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1974.
