

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE OBSERVANCE
OF MEMORIAL DAY AND VETERANS DAY

WHEREAS, because of various Federal and State actions some confusion exists regarding the observance of Memorial Day and Veterans Day as official holidays, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the City of Urbana be certain which day is to be officially observed as such holidays, and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the Urbana City Council that from time to time the date of the official observance may be changed to the benefit of the City of Urbana and its employees.


THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL THAT:

1. Each year, at least ten (10) days prior to the date declared hereunder by the Mayor of the City of Urbana to be the date on which the City of Urbana shall officially observe Memorial Day and Veterans Day as an official City of Urbana holiday, the Mayor shall proclaim the date on which the City of Urbana shall officially observe such holidays.

2. This Ordinance shall be effective as of and from this date.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the Members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 1 day of May, A.D. 1974.
