## ORDINANCE NO. <u>747</u>6-47

## AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 29.15 OF THE URBANA CITY CODE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, on the 1st day of October, 1973, passed and approved a certain ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Regulating Numbering of Buildings and Lots", being Ordinance No. 7374-33, and

WHEREAS, the present provisions of Chapter 29, Section 29.15, "House Numbers" duplicates the provisions of the said Ordinance No. 7374-33,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the following section of the Urbana City Code is herewith and hereby deleted:

> "The City engineer or the public engineer acting in that capacity for the city shall have authority to designate the house number on all streets within the city. It shall be unlawful for any person to post any number on any house in the city other than the number assigned by the city engineer".
