

ORDINANCE NO. 7475-50

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A 1% MUNICIPAL USE TAX  
FOR THE SALE OF PROPERTY PURCHASED OUT OF STATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. A tax is hereby imposed in accordance with provisions of Section 8-11-6 of the Illinois Municipal Code upon the privilege of using in the municipality any item of tangible personal property which is purchased outside Illinois at retail from a retailer, and which is titled or registered with an agency of Illinois government. The tax shall be at a rate of 1% of the selling price to have the meaning as defined in the Use Tax Act, approved July 14, 1955.

Section 2. Such tax shall be collected by the Illinois Department of Revenue for all municipalities imposing the tax and shall be paid before the title of certificate of registration for the personal property is issued.

Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to transmit to the Illinois Department of Revenue a certified copy of this ordinance not later than five (5) days after its effective date.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be published within ten (10) days of its enactment as provided in Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code and shall be effective on the first day of the month following the expiration of such publication period.

This ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, passed by a majority vote of the Aldermen and Alderwomen holding office all in accordance with the Ordinances of the City of Urbana and the Statutes of the State of Illinois heretofore adopted and in effect.
