

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT

WHEREAS, after due publication, a Public Hearing was held on the 7th day of November, 1974, concerning the Petition filed in Plan Commission Case #942, and

WHEREAS, the Urbana Plan Commission, at the conclusion of said Public Hearing, recommended approval of the request that a Conditional Use Permit for a Day Care Center on the premises described below be granted,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. A conditional use permit for the use of the following described property as a Day Care Center is herewith granted subject to the conditions and limitations contained in Section 2:

Lot 7 of block 58 of Seminary Addition to the City of Urbana, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian,

commonly known as 912 West Springfield, Urbana, Illinois.

Section 2. The conditional use permit hereby granted is subject to the following conditions and limitations:

1. That the conditional use permit would be valid only as long as the State license remained in effect;
2. That the number of children involved in the conditional use permit would not exceed twenty-two (22).


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1 - 2 - 4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.
