AN ORDINANCE CHANGING A STREET NAME

WHEREAS, there presently exists some confusion regarding the existence of two "Oak Streets", and

WHEREAS, under Chapter 24, Section 11-80-19 the Corporate Authorities have the power to change the name of any street, and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Engineering Department that one of the existing "Oak Streets" be redesignated to that of Cottage Grove Avenue,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the eastern most street presently designated as "Oak Street", which is located one block to the east of Hickory Street between University Avenue and Park Street, shall from the effective date of this Ordinance, and thereafter, be designated and known as Cottage Grove Avenue.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
