

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING MOTOR VEHICLE PARKING  
ON CERTAIN PORTIONS OF PERKINS ROAD  
IN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,  
A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois, and the City of Urbana, Illinois, a municipal corporation, for improved traffic movement, and public safety, contemplate an improvement of Cunningham Avenue from Station 104 + 45.00 to Station 126 + 50.00 and Perkins Road from Station 208 + 82.00 to Station 220 + 50.00 in said City during the calendar year 1975, in accordance with estimates, plans, maps, drawings, and specifications, and contemplated agreements, and pursuant to the project designation of F.A.P. System, State Section 28x-I-1, City Section, 182-TL-CS, City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, FOR SAID CITY, that motor vehicle parking and any parking is hereby prohibited on Perkins Road, in said City, on both sides for 549 feet East of the Centerline of Cunningham Avenue to 619 feet West of the Centerline of Cunningham Avenue, in said City.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1 - 2 - 4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 7TH day of April, 1975.

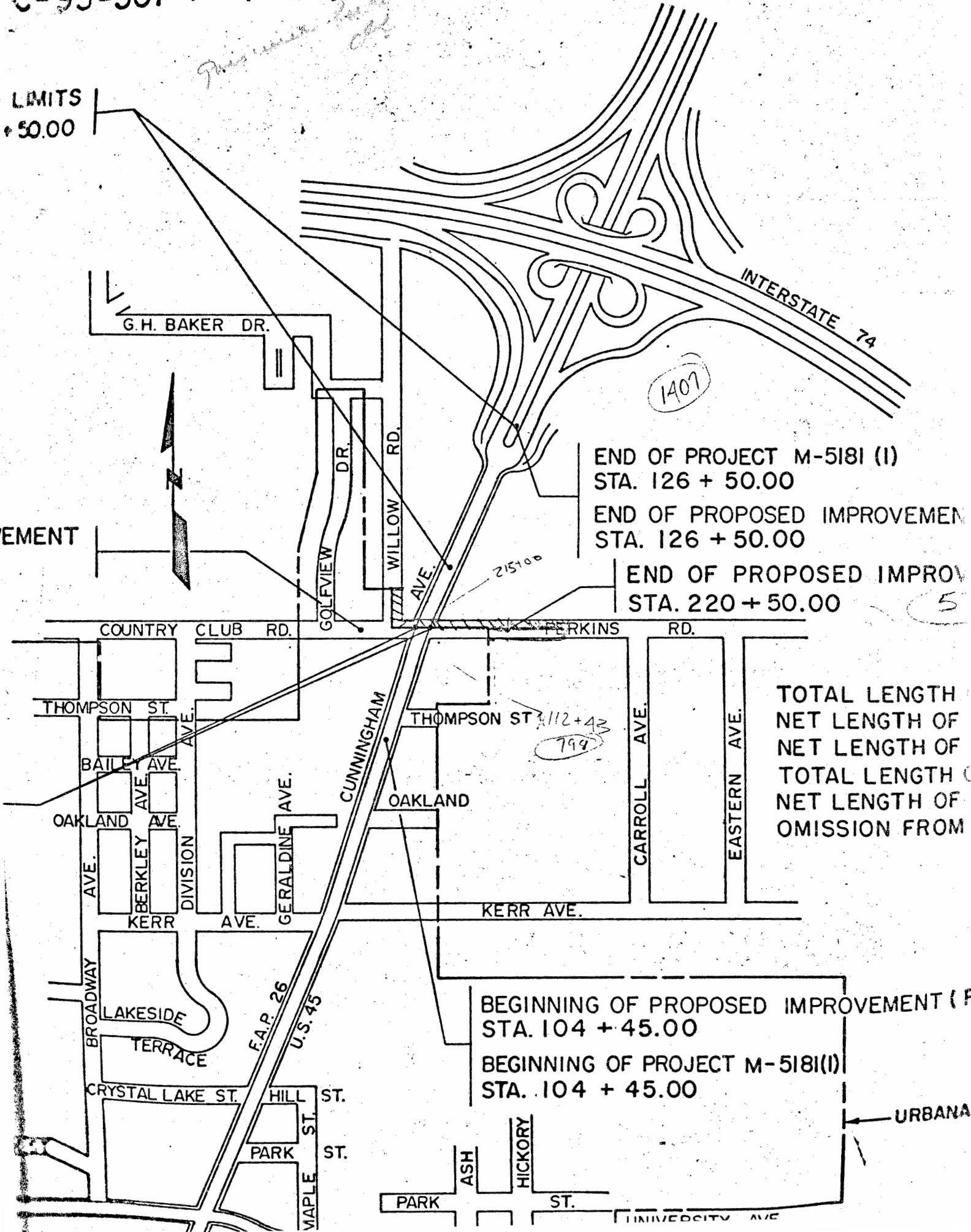
