

ORDINANCE NO. 7475-78

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE
URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. Parking shall be prohibited on the east side of Division Street from Kerr Avenue to Oakland Avenue, and that Schedule IX be modified accordingly.

Section 2. The Traffic Engineer of the City of Urbana is hereby authorized and directed to establish crosswalks at the following locations:

- (A) Florida Avenue at Thomas Payne School.
- (B) Broadway Avenue at Washington School.
- (C) Washington Street at Prairie School.
- (D) Washington Street at Brookens School.

Section 3. The Traffic Engineer of the City of Urbana is hereby authorized and directed to post appropriate signs.

Section 4. Left turns shall be prohibited onto Iowa Street at the Urbana High School parking lot for traffic southbound on the school lot (preventing eastbound turns onto Iowa Street), and that Schedule IV be modified accordingly.

Section 5. Motor vehicles northbound on Smith Road shall stop for Washington Street and that Schedule VII be modified accordingly.

Section 6. The Traffic Engineer of the City of Urbana is hereby authorized and directed to cause signs to be erected giving notice of said Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the Members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 4th day of November, 1974.
