

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING TERMS OF OFFICE OF APPOINTED OFFICERS, COMMISSIONERS AND BOARD MEMBERS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. From the effective date of this Ordinance the term of office of all City officials hereafter appointed by the Mayor, shall expire at Midnight of June 30 next following the date of appointment, unless such officer resigns, or is removed by the Mayor.

Section 2. Section 2.76 of the Urbana City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec.2.76. Terms of Office of Commissioners.

The mayor shall, when recommending appointments to boards and commissions of the city, also recommend the appropriate terms of such appointments as shall be necessary to create a properly staggered commission membership; that confirmation of such appointments shall then constitute confirmation also of the terms of such appointments. The mayor shall recommend a term of office different than that provided in the ordinance creating such board or commission only when necessary to achieve a properly staggered membership.

The term of appointments to boards and commissions of the city of Urbana, Illinois, hereafter made shall expire at Midnight on June 30th which is the first, second, third, fourth or fifth June 30th following the appointment as appropriate for the respective terms as required by the ordinance governing the membership and terms of such board or commission."

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of April, A.D. 1975.
