

ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY
TO THE CITY OF URBANA

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described territory is entirely dedicated Right-of-way and is situated in unincorporated territory adjacent to and contiguous to the City of Urbana, Illinois, and is partly within each of the Eastern-Prairie Fire Protection District and the Carroll Fire Protection District, and Notice was given to the Trustees of the said Fire Protection Districts, said Notices being mailed on May 1, 1975, that this Ordinance would be voted upon at the regular meeting of this Council at 7:30 P.M., Monday, May 19, 1975, and the Affidavit of mailing such notices was duly recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County, Illinois, and

WHEREAS, a written Petition signed by the Urbana Township Road Commissioners has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, requesting annexation thereof to the City of Urbana, and

WHEREAS, no electors reside on the territory proposed to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that said Petition complies with all requirements of the law therefor, and

WHEREAS, the majority of the Members of the Council are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the People of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said territory be annexed to and made a part of the said City,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

Section 1. That the following described real estate, viz:

That part of a right-of-way commonly known as Perkins Road which is the thirty-three feet lying North of the South line of Section Four, Township Nineteen North, Range Nine East of the Third Principal Meridian and which is between the extension of the East right-of-way of Willow Road and the extension of the East line of lot two of a subdivision of the West One-Half of the Northwest One-Quarter of Section Nine, Township Nineteen North, Range Nine East of the Third Principal Meridian; and also that part of a right-of-way commonly known as Willow Road which is the thirty feet lying East of the West line of said Section Four, and which is the three hundred thirty and forty-five hundredths feet, more or less, lying between the South line of Section Four and the Easterly extension of the North line of a lot at the extreme Southeast corner of Section Five, Township Nineteen North, Range Nine East of the Third Principal Meridian, which is described in an annexation ordinance, City of Urbana, dated April 1, 1957; containing .95 acres, more or less, all situated in said Section Four, and in

Champaign County, Illinois,

Commonly known as Willow Road and Perkins Road,
Urbana, Illinois,


be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Urbana, Illinois.

Section 2. That the City Clerk be authorized and directed to file for record a certified copy of this Ordinance together with an accurate map of the territory hereinabove described in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds for Champaign County, Illinois.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage and recording as provided by law.




be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Urbana, Illinois.






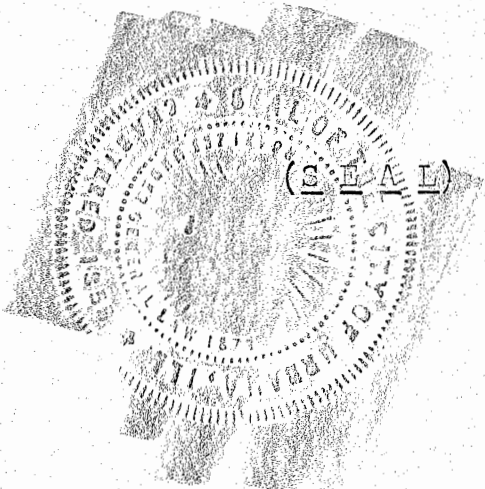
