

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING MOTOR VEHICLE PARKING  
ON CERTAIN PORTIONS OF PHILO ROAD AND FLORIDA AVENUE  
IN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,  
A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois, and the City of Urbana, Illinois, a municipal corporation, for improved traffic movement, and public safety, contemplate an improvement of Philo Road from Station 2 + 33.00 to Station 15 + 66.95 and Florida Avenue from Station 100 + 79.70 to Station 128 + 68.07 in said City during the calendar year 1975, in accordance with estimates, plans, maps, drawings, and specifications, and contemplated agreements, and pursuant to the project designation of F.A.U. System, State Section 200-I, City Section 186-C.S., City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, FOR SAID CITY, that motor vehicle parking and any parking is hereby prohibited on Philo Road, in said City, on both sides for approximately 536 feet North of the Centerline of Florida Avenue to approximately 798 feet South of the Centerline of Florida Avenue, and also parking, other than parallel, is prohibited on Florida Avenue, in the said City, on both sides for approximately 1,290 feet West of the Centerline of Philo Road to approximately 1,520 feet East of the Centerline of Philo Road, in the said City.


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1 - 2 - 4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 6th day of October, 1975.

SAID CITY, that motor vehicle parking  
and any parking is hereby prohibited  
on Philo Road, in said City, on both  
sides for approximately 536 feet North  
of the Centerline of Florida Avenue  
to approximately 798 feet South of the  
Centerline of Florida Avenue, and also  
parking, other than parallel, is prohibited  
on Florida Avenue, in the said City,  
on both sides for approximately 1,290  
feet West of the Centerline of Philo  
Road to approximately 1,520 feet East  
of the Centerline of Philo Road, in  
the said City.

This Ordinance shall be in full force  
and effect from and after its passage  
and publication in accordance with the  
terms of Section 1-2.4 of the Illinois  
Municipal Code.
