

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION
OF CERTAIN TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the following described territory is unincorporated and contains sixty (60) acres or less, and

WHEREAS, the following described territory is presently wholly bounded by the City of Urbana, Illinois, within the meaning of Section 7-1-13 of Chapter 24 of the Illinois Revised Statutes, 1971, and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities have caused notice, stating that annexation of the territory described in the notice is contemplated under this Section, to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the territory to be annexed not less than ten (10) days before the consideration and passage of this Ordinance, to-wit: October 10, 1975,

WHEREAS, since the territory herein annexed is part of the Edge-Scott Fire Protection District and Notice was given to the Trustees of the said Fire Protection District, said Notice being mailed on the 17th day of October, 1975, and which said Notice stated that this Ordinance would be voted upon at the regular meeting of the City Council on the 3rd day of November, 1975, and the Affidavit of mailing such Notice was duly recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County on October 22, 1975, and

WHEREAS, since the territory herein annexed includes highways under the jurisdiction of Urbana Township and Notice was given to the Auditors of Urbana Township and the Township Commissioner of Highways, said Notice being mailed on the 17th day of October, 1975, and which said Notice stated that this Ordinance would be voted upon at the regular meeting of the City Council on the 3rd day of November, 1975, and the Affidavit of mailing such Notice was duly recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County on October 22, 1975,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. The following described territory is hereby annexed:

Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14,
15, 16, 17, 18, 121, 122, 123, 124, 125,
127, 128, and 129 of Weller's Lincolnwood
Subdivision;

and also

That portion of the Sixty (60) foot street
right-of-way known and platted as Lincoln-
wood Drive which lies south of the Southern
property line of Lot 120 of Weller's Lincoln-
wood Subdivision extended, and north of the
Northern property line of Lot 130 in said
Subdivision extended; except that portion of
the Lincolnwood Drive right-of-way which lies
between the Northern and Southern property
lines of Lot 126 of said Subdivision extended,
which has been previously annexed.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative
vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the
members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a
regular meeting of said Council on the 3 day of November,
1975.

and also

That portion of the Sixty (60) foot street right-of-way known and platted as Lincolnwood Drive which lies south of the Southern property line of Lot 120 of Weller's Lincolnwood Subdivision extended, and north of the Northern property line of Lot 130 in said Subdivision extended; except that portion of the Lincolnwood Drive right-of-way which lies between the Northern and Southern property lines of Lot 126 of said Subdivision extended, which has been previously annexed.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 3 day of November, 1975.

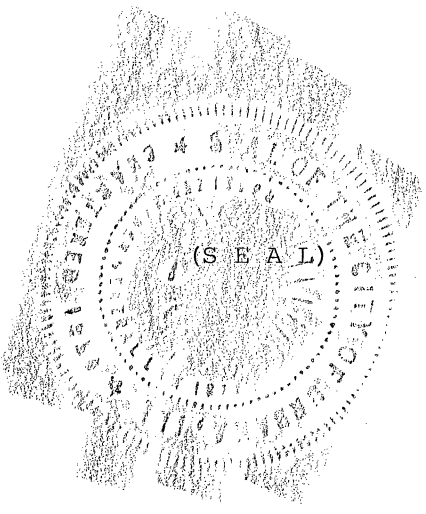
