

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING MOTOR VEHICLE PARKING
ON CERTAIN PORTIONS OF BRADLEY AVENUE
IN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,
A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois, and the City of Urbana, Illinois, a municipal corporation, for improved traffic movement, and public safety, contemplate an improvement of Bradley Avenue from Station 98 + 00 to Station 121 + 93.79 in said City during the calendar year 1976, in accordance with estimates, plans, maps, drawings, and specifications, and contemplated agreements, and pursuant to the project designation of F.A.U. System, County Section 258, City Section 187-C.S., City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, FOR SAID CITY, that motor vehicle parking and any parking other than parallel, is prohibited on Bradley Avenue on both sides for approximately 2,400 feet West of the centerline of Lincoln Avenue within the limits of this project, in the said City, and the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance and the appropriate appendices are hereby amended to reflect such.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1 - 2 - 4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.



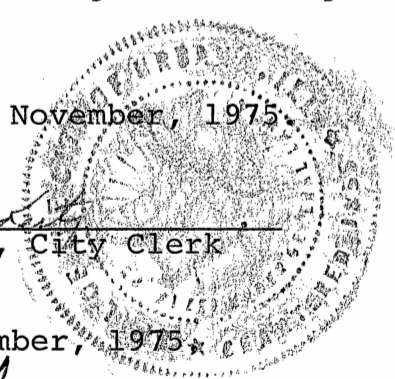

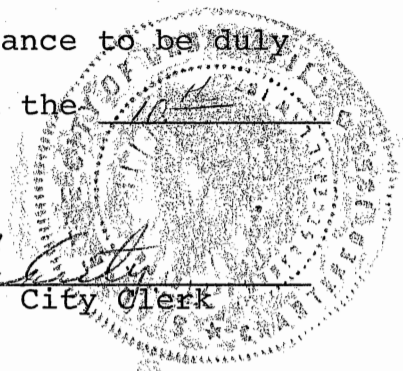
