

ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY
TO THE CITY OF URBANA

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described territory is situated in unincorporated territory adjacent to and contiguous to the City of Urbana, Illinois, and is not part of any Fire Protection District, and

WHEREAS, a written Petition signed by all of the owners of Record and all electors residing therein of all land within such territory, has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, requesting annexation thereof to the City of Urbana, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that said Petition complies with all requirements of the law therefor, and

WHEREAS, the majority of the Members of the Council are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the People of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said territory be annexed to and made a part of the said City,

WHEREAS, since the territory herein annexed includes highways under the jurisdiction of Urbana Township and Notice was given to the Auditors of Urbana Township and the Township Commissioner of Highways, said Notice being mailed on the 2nd day of December, 1975, and which said Notice stated that this Ordinance would be voted upon at the regular meeting of the City Council on the 15th day of December, 1975, and the Affidavit of mailing such Notice was duly recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County on December 3, 1975,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

Section 1. That the following described real estate, viz:

Lot 857 in Ennis Ridge Eighteenth Subdivision; along with the full 80' width of the street right of way known and platted as Vine Street, from the South line of said Lot 857, extended to the South line of Lot 868, Ennis Ridge Eighteenth Subdivision, extended, and also the full 60' width of the street right of way known and platted as Brookens Drive from the

East line of Vine Street to the East line of said Lot 857, extended (said rights of way being reannexed); all located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 20, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, Champaign County, Illinois.

commonly known as 401 E. Brookens Drive, Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Urbana, Illinois.

Section 2. That the City Clerk be authorized and directed to file for record a certified copy of this Ordinance together with an accurate map of the territory hereinabove described in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds for Champaign County, Illinois.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage and recording as provided by law.

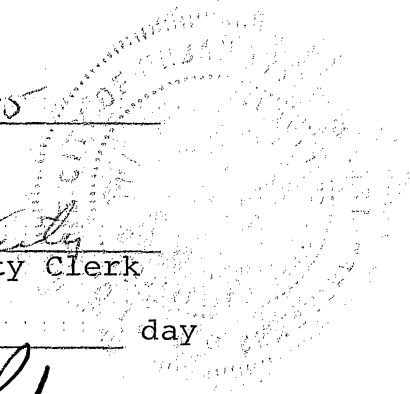

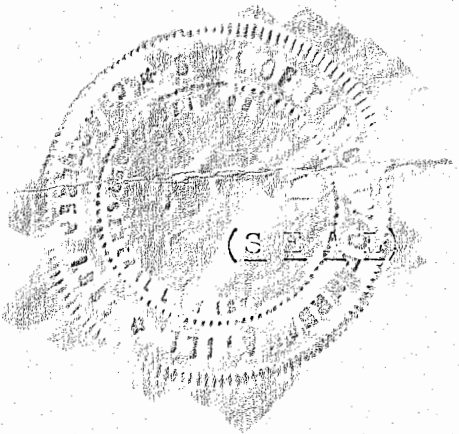
