

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PAVING OF  
THE INTERSECTION OF FLORIDA AVENUE AND PHILO ROAD

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of  
Urbana that:

Section 1. A local improvement shall be made in the  
City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois, the nature, character,  
locality and description of which shall be as follows:

Pavement of Philo Road from a point approximately  
770 feet south of Florida Avenue northerly to a point approximately  
570 feet north of Florida Avenue, a distance of approximately  
0.241 miles; and Federal-Aid Secondary Route No. 520 (Florida  
Avenue) extending from a point near Cottage Grove Avenue easterly  
to a point near James Cherry Drive, a distance of approximately  
0.527 miles.

The said improvement shall be constructed in a good  
and workmanlike manner and shall conform to the State of  
Illinois Department of Public Works & Buildings Division of  
Highways "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction,"  
dated August 1, 1968, and to the plans attached herewith and made  
a part hereof.

All materials used in this improvement shall conform  
to the aforementioned specifications where applicable.

Engineering and Inspection:

For the purpose of constructing this improvement in  
accordance with the elevations, dimensions and positions as  
herein provided for, the grades and lines of construction shall  
be given by use of stakes and other necessary devices as the  
work progresses; and to protect those benefited by this improve-  
ment from the use of improper material and poor workmanship, all  
material used shall be inspected, and all labor performed shall  
be superintended. To this end, the Board of Local Improvements  
shall employ the necessary competent engineers, inspectors, and

superintendents during the construction of the work.

All work in connection with the improvement herein provided for shall be executed in a good and workmanlike manner and under the superintendence of the Board of Local Improvements.

Section 2. The recommendations of the Board of Local Improvements and the estimate of the cost thereof, both hereto attached, be, and the same are hereby approved.

Section 3. The said improvement shall be made, and the cost thereof which is estimated to be \$875,000.00 shall be paid for by applying thereto the sum of \$50,000.00 from the allotment to the municipality of its share of the motor fuel tax collected by the state, the use of this amount for such purpose having been previously approved and such amount having been designated for the purpose as provided by law; by applying \$420,000.00 Federal Aid Urban Funds, the use of this amount for such purpose having been previously approved and such amount having been designated for the purpose as provided by law; by applying \$90,000.00 State Safety Funds, the use of this amount for such purpose having been previously approved and such amount having been designated for the purpose as provided by law; by applying thereto the proceeds of a certain bond or bonds which may be issued by the City of Urbana and secured by the pledging of the tax levies upon properties located within the proposed City of Urbana Special Service Area Number One.

The sum of \$36,000.00, being the amount included in the estimate of said Public Engineer hereto attached as the cost of the engineering, supervision, inspection, and cost of making, levying, and collection of the special tax levy, including court costs, all as estimated shall be applied and set forth in said estimate of cost, as provided in an act entitled, "An Act Concerning Local Improvements", as amended.

Section 4. For the purpose of anticipating the collection of the tax levy for the said Special Service Area, bonds may be issued payable out of such tax levy, signed by the Mayor of the municipality and attested by its Clerk, under the corporate seal of the said municipality.

Section 5. For the completion of the improvement described in this ordinance it is necessary that the property shown on the attached sheets be acquired:

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the Members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a special meeting of said Council on the 28 day of July, 1975.

RECOMMENDATION AS TO PAVING OF FLORIDA AVENUE AND PHILO ROAD

To the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois:

The Board of Local Improvements heretofore appointed and now serving in that capacity, herewith submits a draft of an ordinance for the improvement of Florida Avenue between a point near Cottage Grove Avenue and a point near James Cherry Drive (a distance of .527 miles) and also an improvement of Philo Road from a point approximately 770 feet south of Florida Avenue to a point approximately 570 feet north of Florida Avenue (a distance of approximately .241 miles) by grading, curbing and draining the same and constructing a concrete pavement thereon as described in the accompanying ordinance; and

Submits herewith an estimate of the cost thereof by the Public Engineer of the City of Urbana, Illinois; and

Recommends the passage of the said ordinance and the making of the said improvement, the cost thereof to be paid for by special assessments.

ESTIMATE

CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS  
FLORIDA AVENUE IMPROVEMENT

TO: The BOARD OF LOCAL IMPROVEMENTS of the City of Urbana, Illinois

Gentlemen:

I hereby submit an estimate of the cost, including labor and material, cost of engineering services and inspection, bond discount, court costs and other lawful expenses of a local improvement consisting of: Federal-Aid Secondary Route No. 524 (Ill. 130) extending from a point approximately ~~77.0~~ 770 feet south of Florida Avenue northerly to a point approximately 570 feet north of Florida Avenue, a distance of approximately 0.241 miles and Federal-Aid Secondary Route No. 520 (Florida Avenue) extending from a point near Cottage Grove Avenue easterly to a point near James Cherry Drive, a distance of approximately 0.527 miles. The proposed improvement on Illinois 130 consists of constructing a Portland Cement Concrete surface 44 feet in width with a bituminous surface transition at each end. The proposed improvement on Florida Avenue consists of constructing a Portland Cement Concrete surface 44 feet in width. At the intersection of these two routes it is proposed to install a traffic control signal and along both routes it is proposed to install street lighting.

All materials of every kind and character to be used in the construction of this improvement shall be first class quality, suitable for the purpose for which they are to be used, and subject to the inspection and approval of the Board of Local Improvements of the City of Urbana, Champaign, Illinois.

All work shall be constructed in a workmanlike manner under the superintendence of the Board of Local Improvements of the City of Urbana, Illinois.

All construction methods and materials used in construction of the improvement herein provided for shall conform with the requirements of the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction," issued by the State of Illinois, Department of Transportation, Division of Highways and adopted January 2, 1971, a copy of which is on file with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois.

I have estimated the cost of making said improvement at \$875,000.00 which estimate is itemized as follows:

1. Construction Cost	\$600,000.00
2. R. O. W.	114,000.00
3. Design Engineering	35,000.00
4. Construction Engineering	90,000.00
5. Cost of Levying, making and collecting taxes and lawful expenses attending same	36,000.00

And I hereby certify that in my opinion the above estimate does not exceed the probable cost of the improvement proposed and the lawful expenses attending the improvement.
