AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,  
ILLINOIS:

That the attached Schedule of Fees, a copy of which is attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference, is hereby adopted and approved as the established license fees prevailing in the City of Urbana, Illinois, said schedule being adopted as a part of Section 17, Chapter 18 of the Urbana City Code.


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
