

AN ORDINANCE LICENSING CERTAIN DEVICES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. No person shall allow, suffer or permit any coin operated electrical device or coin operated food dispensing device to be used on premises owned, leased or controlled by such person without first having obtained a license for such device from the City of Urbana, Illinois. Provided, however, no license shall be required for any machine made operative by the insertion of coins in a total of not more than 5¢ (provided such is not connected to an outside electrical power source) regardless of what such machine dispenses.

Section 2. Definitions:

a) As used herein, the words "coin operated electrical device" shall be construed to mean any device which is made operative by the insertion of coin(s) and is attached to an outside electrical power source for mechanical operations or illumination such as (but not limited to) pin ball machines, juke boxes, shuffle board games, cigarette machines, soft drink dispensers, sandwich dispensers.

b) As used herein, the words "coin operated food dispensing device" shall be construed to mean any device which is made operative to dispense food by the insertion of coin(s).

c) As used herein, "food" shall be construed to mean matter or liquids or any combination, intended for ingestion by humans.

Section 3. All coin operated electrical devices and coin operated food dispensing devices shall be kept in good working order at all times and upon notice to the possessor of the said device that it is not functioning properly, shall be clearly marked as "out of order" while the said device is not functioning properly. In addition, any device which dispenses food, whether attached to an outside electrical power source or not, shall be kept in a clean and sanitary manner at all times.

Section 4. The owner of any coin operated electrical device or coin operated food dispensing device shall be the person responsible for securing the City license provided for herein.

Section 5. The fees to be charged for the license required under this Ordinance shall be as is set from time to time by duly enacted Ordinance.

Section 6. Penalty. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00). Each day that a violation occurs shall be considered a separate violation for the purposes of this Ordinance. In addition to the penalty set forth herein, the license of the person violating any provisions of this Ordinance may be suspended or revoked as provided in Chapter 18 of the Urbana City Code.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the Members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 17th day of May, 1976.
