

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTERS  
14 AND 18 OF THE URBANA CITY CODE FOR THE  
DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE PURSUANT TO THE CHAMPAIGN-  
URBANA SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Urbana to provide for the disposal of solid waste generated within the City's limits; and

WHEREAS, An Ordinance Approving Agreement for the Disposal of Solid Waste (Ordinance No. 7576-47, passed by the City Council on December 1, 1975, and approved by the Mayor on December 5, 1975) provides for the establishment of the Champaign-Urbana Solid Waste Disposal System and for the operation and maintenance of solid waste disposal facilities pursuant to the Champaign-Urbana Solid Waste Disposal System Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

1. That Section 14.7, entitled "License Required", of Article II, entitled "Sanitary Hauling", of Chapter 14, entitled "Garbage, Trash and Weeds" of the Urbana City Code be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Every sanitary hauler or other person engaged in the collection of garbage, trash or the like within the City of Urbana must obtain a license from the Municipal Collector's Office, and pay the annual license fee as set forth in the Schedule of Fees, Chapter 18 of this Code. Other sanitary haulers or other persons engaged in the collection of garbage, trash or the like must, as required pursuant to the Champaign-Urbana Solid Waste Disposal Agreement, obtain a license from the Municipal Collector's Office and pay the annual license fee as set forth in the Schedule of Fees, Chapter 18 of this Code. Such licenses shall expire on June 30 of each year, unless renewed by advance annual payment of the license fee.

2. That Section 14.17, entitled "Use of Sanitary Landfill", of Article III, entitled "Urbana Sanitary Landfill", of Chapter 14, entitled "Garbage, Trash and Weeds" be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 14.17 Establishment

The area established by resolution as the Urbana Sanitary Landfill, or any other area so established, shall be considered to be the City grounds for solid waste disposal and shall be subject to the jurisdiction and control of the Champaign-Urbana Solid Waste Disposal System Agreement.<sup>5</sup>

3. That Section 14.18, entitled "Monthly Billing System", of Article III, entitled "Urbana Sanitary Landfill", of Chapter 14, entitled "Garbage, Trash and Weeds" of the Urbana City Code be and is hereby repealed.

4. That Section 14.19, entitled "Disposition of Wastes", of Article III, entitled "Urbana Sanitary Landfill", of Chapter 14, entitled "Garbage, Trash and Weeds" of the Urbana City Code be and is hereby repealed.

5. That Section 14.20, entitled "Landfill Rules and Regulations", of Article III, entitled "Urbana Sanitary Landfill", of Chapter 14, entitled "Garbage, Trash and Weeds" of the Urbana City Code be and is hereby repealed.

6. That Subsection B of Part IV, entitled "Miscellaneous", of the Section 18.17, entitled "Schedule of Fees" of Chapter 18, entitled "Licenses", be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

B. Sanitary Haulers. (Per vehicle used in the collection of garbage, trash or the like). . . \$100.00

7. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, but in no event shall it become effective before July 1, 1976.

This ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the Members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 21 day of June, 1976.
