

ORDINANCE NO. 7576-87

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND AMENDING CERTAIN
SECTIONS OF THE URBANA CITY CODE CHAPTER 2,
ARTICLE XV, ENTITLED "PARKING COMMISSION"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That the following Sections of Chapter 2,
Article XV of the Urbana City Code are herewith and hereby repealed:

Section 2.57, entitled "Creation, composition; term of
office".

Section 2.58, entitled "Meetings of the Commission;
compensation".

Section 2.59, entitled "Duties generally".

Subsections (3) and (6) of Section 2.60, entitled
"Parking administrator".

Section 2.61, entitled "Parking Meter maintenance man".

Section 2.62, entitled "Annual report".

Section 2.63, entitled "Rental spaces".

Section 2. That the following Sections of Chapter 2,
Article XV, as amended, are hereby further amended as follows:

(a) By amending Subsection (1) of Section 2.60 to read
as follows: The Mayor may appoint, with the approval of the City
Council, an administrator to supervise the operation of all the on-
street and off-street facilities of the motor vehicle parking system
and properties of the City of Urbana. Said administrator shall be
bonded in the amount of \$20,000.00 annually.

(b) By amending Subsection (2) of Section 2.60 to read
as follows: Said administrator shall be authorized to supervise the
collection of all parking meter monies, rental receipts and all other
revenues derived from operation of the parking facilities. Said
administrator shall deposit all monies received in the motor vehicle
parking revenue fund of the City. Said administrator shall file the
deposit slip with the City Clerk.

(c) By amending Subsection (4) of Section 2.60 to read
as follows: The administrator shall issue citations and may authorize
his or her employees to issue citations against any person or persons

violating any of the rules, regulations or ordinances pertaining to parking meters or rental spaces established in accordance with Section 17-1 of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance.

(d) By amending Subsection (5) of Section 2.60 to read as follows: Neither the administrator nor any of his or her employees authorized to issue citations shall be members of the City Police Department. Employees authorized to issue citations shall be limited to the duties as set forth in this article. The administrator shall be empowered and authorized to enforce all of the rules and regulations approved by the City Council.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois at a regular meeting of said Council on the 5TH day of April, 1976.
