

ORDINANCE NO. 7677-15

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO
SUBMIT TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS THE QUESTION OF WHETHER THE ANNUAL
LIBRARY TAX FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION
SHOULD BE INCREASED FROM .2364% TO .35%

WHEREAS, the current annual public library tax rate of
the Urbana Free Library stands at .2364% of assessed valuation; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated expenses as reflected in the
budget of the Urbana Free Library for its fiscal year of 1977/1978
exceeds anticipated revenues in the amount of approximately \$117,000.00;
and

WHEREAS, an increase in the tax rate to .35% is needed
in order for the Urbana Free Library to meet that anticipated
deficit; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois,
in accordance with Chapter 81, Sections 3-1 and 3-3 of the Illinois
Revised Statutes, desires to so increase the tax rate for the
Urbana Free Library; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously ordained by
Ordinance No. 7576-97, which was passed on April 26, 1976 and
approved April 29, 1976, that such special election be held on
September 11, 1976.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, THAT:

Section 1. There shall be a special election to submit
to the voters of the City of Urbana, Illinois, the question of
whether the annual library tax for maintenance and operation should
be increased from .2364% to .35% of the value of all taxable property
in the City on Saturday, the 11th day of September, 1976. The polls
of said election shall be open between the hours of 6:00 o'clock A.M.
and 6:00 o'clock P.M. of said day.

Section 2. For the purposes of said special election,
the City shall be divided into three election precincts or districts.
The boundaries of such precincts and the polling places for each
shall be as hereinafter set forth in the form of election notice
hereinafter set forth in this Ordinance.

Section 3. The City Clerk of the City of Urbana is hereby ordered and directed to cause notice of said election to be given by publishing notice thereof once in both the Champaign-Urbana Courier and the Champaign-Urbana News-Gazette, the same being newspapers published in and having a general circulation within the City of Urbana. The date of such publication shall not be less than 20 days in advance of the date set for said special election and said notice shall be in substantially the following form:

The polls at said special election will be open at 6:00 o'clock A.M. and will be closed at 6:00 o'clock P.M. on the date of the election. All persons qualified and registered to vote at regular City elections are qualified to vote on said question and voters must vote at the polling place designated for the election district in which they reside.


