AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCES
TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 7576-94, entitled "An Ordinance to Provide for the Construction of Sidewalks on Portions of Certain Streets All Within the City of Urbana, State of Illinois", which was passed by the City Council on the 19th day of April, 1976, and approved by the Mayor on the 21st day of April, and which provided for the construction of sidewalks on both sides of Fairlawn Drive between Cottage Grove Avenue and Philo Road, be and the same is hereby repealed.

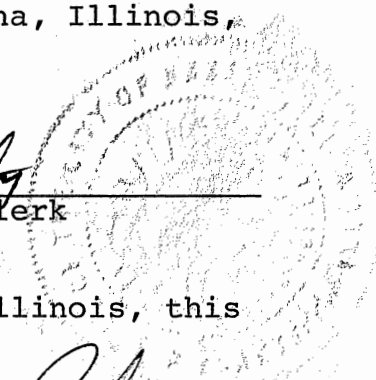

That Ordinance No. 7576-99, entitled "An Ordinance to Provide for the Construction of Sidewalks on Portions of Certain Streets All Within the City of Urbana, State of Illinois", which was passed by the City Council on the 3rd day of May, 1976, and approved by the Mayor on the 5th day of May, 1976, and which provided for the construction of sidewalks on both sides of Montclair Road between Race Street and Vine Street, be and the same is hereby repealed.




BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,


